- 2 scholarships to be awarded
- Only open to residents of Amherst, Auburn, Bedford, Brookline, Candia, Goffstown, Hollis, Hooksett, Hudson, Litchfield, Manchester, Merrimack, Milford, Mont Vernon, Nashua and New Boston
- Special consideration given to applicants going into realty related fields ie: political science, real estate law, taxes, banking etc.

- Individual renewable grants
- looking for students with personal or socio-economic setbacks who make a positive contribution to their community
- must have a minimum 2.0 GPA
- Deadline: 4/30/17

NH Legion Scholarships - American Legion

- 7 scholarships at \$2,000 each
- Looking for students with at least a “B” average in junior and senior year
- Some awards have specific requirements for field of study
- Scholarships based on need and resources
- Deadline: 5/1/17

NH Music Educators Association Scholarship

- 4 awards at \$300
- Eligible students should be pursuing a major in music education
- Will need a letter of recommendation from a music teacher
- Deadline: 5/1/17

Nashua Area Artists’ Association Scholarship

- 2 awards at \$500
- Students must be attending college for a degree focused on the arts
- Will need to include an essay, letter from a teacher and a portfolio
- Mandatory interviews will occur on 5/20/17
- Deadline: 5/6/17

Eight and Forty Scholarship

- Valued at \$3,000
- preference given to students focusing on respiratory therapy or nursing with an interest in lung disease
- must submit an essay and three letters of recommendation

- Deadline: 5/15/17
