EDVestinU – Monthly scholarship opportunity

- Valued at \$1,000
- Randomly selected student wins \$1000 each month
- NH residents only

- Deadline: end of each month

GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program

- Valued at \$10,000
- Must demonstrate; leadership, drive, integrity and citizenship
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Apply online at: www.reaganfoundation.org
- Deadline: 1/5/2017

****NEW**NH Red Sox Service Scholarship**

- \$1,000 scholarship **guaranteed** to someone in our school as long as we have **at least 3** applicants
- Looking at academic performance, community service and financial need
- Will need to submit FAFSA information
- Must include a 500-600 word essay on “*How has your community service defined who you are and influenced your plans for the future?*”
- Will need one letter of recommendation
- Apply at: www.redsoxfoundation.org (New England Red Sox Scholarship)
- Deadline: 1/13/2017 (*please let Mrs. McAllister in student services know if you plan to apply*)

National Multiple Sclerosis Society Scholarship

- Awards range from \$1,000-\$3,000
- Must have MS or have a parent with MS
- Applicants will be judged based on financial need, academic record, leadership and participation in school or community activities, work experience, an outside appraisal, goals and aspirations, special circumstances, and an essay (written by the applicant) regarding the impact of MS on their life

- Deadline: 1/18/17

Military Commanders Scholarship Fund

- Valued at \$5,000
- Applicants must be dependent children of active duty, reserve, National Guard or retired members of the United States military who hold valid Exchange & Commissary shopping privileges
- Must have a minimum 3.5 GPA
- Only the first 100 applicants are accepted

- Deadline: 2/17/17 (APPLY EARLY)

Simon Youth Community Scholarships

- Valued at \$1,500
- Students must show academic promise and financial need
- Only open to students who live within 50 miles of a Simon property
- Apply online at: www.syf.org/scholarships
- Deadline: unknown

Engineering Scholarships – SAE International

- Several scholarships with values ranging from \$400 to **full tuition!**
- Must be pursuing a degree in Engineering or related technology
- University Sponsored: for students studying engineering at specific schools
- Undesignated: for students studying engineering programs at any school (both available)
- Must be attending an accredited program
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 (SAT requirements vary)
