## *NH Wrestling Officials Association Scholarship*

- Valued at \$500
- Must be a varsity wrestler
- Will need a short essay
- Deadline: 2/11/17

## **\*\*Perry Scholarship Fund – New Hampshire Charitable Foundation\*\***

- Limited number of large awards
- Only residents of Milford, Wilton, and Lyndeborough are eligible (must have lived here for 2 years or more)
- Based on motivation, academic and community achievements, and proven ability to accomplish goals
- Will be required to submit three essays (one is optional but recommended)
- Will need two recommendations
- Financial need also considered
- Interview for finalists required (April 8<sup>th</sup> in the morning so you must be available)

- Valued at \$2,000
- Must have at least a 3.0 GPA and be attending a NEACRAO member institute (the list can be found at <http://neacrao.org/membership/member-institutions/>)

- Applications need to be brought to student services by 3/8/17

## Lakes Region Tourism Scholarship

- Up to \$1,000 scholarship renewable
- Students majoring in or studying tourism or hospitality or marketing related fields
- Based on scholastic performance as well as financial need
- Required essay
- Deadline: 3/25/17

- Scholarships may be up to \$1,000 each
- Must be pursuing a degree in business related field
- Must have completed four or more of the following courses: computer classes, accounting, marketing, office practices and procedures, business law, business communications
- Application includes a 500 word essay
- Deadline: 3/27/17

Nuts, Bolts & Thingamajigs scholarship program

- Awards up to \$2,500 and including Solidworks™ CAD software
- Must be attending a community college for a career in manufacturing
- Must have a minimum of 2.5 GPA
