

Guidelines for your Work Cited Page

- Begin your Works Cited page on a separate page at the end of your research paper. It should have the same one-inch margins and last name, page number header as the rest of your paper.
- Label the page Works Cited and center the words Works Cited at the top of the page.
- Double space all citations, but do not skip spaces between entries.
- Indent the second and subsequent lines of citations by 0.5 inches to create a hanging indent.
- For every entry, you must determine the Medium (Type) of Publication. Most will be listed as Print or Web sources, but other possibilities may include Film, CD-ROM, or DVD.
- Writers are no longer required to provide URLs for Web entries. (Your teacher may require it)
- If you're citing from an online database copy and paste the MLA citation provided for you.
- Capitalize each word in the titles of articles, books, ex: *Gone with the Wind*, *The Art of War*, *There Is Nothing Left to Lose*.
- Use *italics* (instead of underlining) for the titles of books & magazines and **quotation marks** for titles of poems, articles.
