- > For students who express a career interest in medicine, athletic training, nursing, and/or the care and treatment of sports injuries
- > Students must have maintained a 3.0 GPA through first semester of senior year
- ➤ Must get a recommendation from Mr. Maurais and Dr. Craven
- ➤ Deadline: 3/15/17

New Hampshire School Board Association Scholarship

- ➤ Valued at \$1,000
- > Students interested in entering the field of education
- Must be a child or grandchild of a current school board member
- > Will be based on academic success, extra-curricular activities and community service
- Must include an essay on "Steps that my local school board should take to promote student achievement" and three letters of recommendation

- > Students must show academic excellence and aptitude for studies proposed; exemplary citizenship, character, and serious-mindedness; and financial need
- > Application is lengthy and early applications are preferred
- > Applications can be found online at www.phillips-scholarship.org
- ➤ <u>Deadline</u>: preferred deadline 4/3/17

Anthony W. Romano & Vernon C. Kelley Memorial Scholarships

- > Valued at \$500 and \$1,500
- > Student's family must be receiving or have received assistance from the NH housing authority
- > Available online at: www.nhhac.org or in student services
- ➤ <u>Deadline</u>: 4/7/17

NH Association of Broadcasters - Student Broadcaster Scholarship

- ➤ Valued at \$2.500
- > Must be permanent residents of the state of NH
- ➤ Can be enrolling in a 2 or 4 year program related to over-the-air broadcasting
- > "Highest priority will be given to students with the most limited financial resources"
- ➤ <u>Deadline</u>: 4/7/2017

New England Association for College Admission Counseling - Essay Contest

- > \$1000 will be awarded to a student in NH
