- 2 different awards from \$10,000 to \$25,000
- Focus on student's personal ambition and drive
- Both state and national scholarships available

- Deadlines: 12/15/16-**apply early!** Only the first 10,000 received will be eligible

Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program

- Valued at up to \$30,000 a year
- Must be enrolling in a four-year institution
- Must have a GPA above 3.5
- Must score 1200 or above on the reading and math section of the SAT or 26 or better on the ACT
- Must demonstrate significant need and have a family income under \$95,000

- Deadline: 11/30/16

Most Valuable Student- Elks National Foundation

- 500 four year awards ranging from \$4,000 - \$60,000 (\$1,000 - \$15,000 per year)
- Looking for student leaders
- Must show scholarship, leadership and financial need
- Must be a U.S. Citizen

Young Entrepreneur Award- National Federation of Independent Businesses

- Awards range from \$2,000 to \$15,000
- Must be entering an accredited college at some level
- Must own/operate your own business

Washington Crossing Foundation

- Awards range from \$500 - \$5000
- For students planning a career of service to local or state government
- Must include an essay and letters of recommendation

High School Oratorical Scholarship Program - American Legion

- Awards range from \$1,500 to \$18,000
- Must be a US citizen to apply
- Students are expected to prepare a 8-10 minute speech on some topic of the constitution
- Will first need to compete at the local level

Co-op Education Scholarship – National Co-op Scholarship Program

- 175 scholarships valued at \$6,000 (renewable)
- Must have a GPA of 3.5 (B+) or better
- Must complete a 250-300 word essay
- Must be planning to participate in a college co-op program at one of the following schools:
 - **Clarkson University, Drexel University, Johnson and Wales University, Merrimack College, Rochester Institute of Technology, SUNY Oswego, University of Toledo, University of Cincinnati, UMass Lowell, or Wentworth Institute of Technology**
