Ticket Sales

Students who are current on their class dues (\$20/year) may purchase Prom Tickets for \$70 up until April 27th. Ticket cost include transportation, dinner, entertainment and a five-hour sunset cruise on Lake Winnepesaukee. Cash or check, made out to Milford High School, is acceptable.

Protocols for Prom Attendance

1. All Prom attendees must ride the bus to and from the prom. No exceptions.
2. Permission forms are required and are due by Monday, May 01, 2017.
 - All Prom attendees are required to complete the Prom permission form.
 - All out-of-district attendees are required to complete the Prom Guest form.
3. Excused absences and early dismissals: A parent must call into the office stating the reason for the absence or early dismissal for it to be excused.
4. The Mt. Washington Cruise staff requires that there be no running or jumping on board, and that attendees obey crew members when they give direction.
5. All tickets sold are for specific individuals. No transfers.
6. Students must arrive 30 minutes before departure to insure a timely departure.
7. If a student is concerned about motion sickness, they may want to take Dramamine or an equivalent 30-60 minutes before boarding. Chaperones will have a limited supply of Dramamine (less drowsy) on boat.

*******Students are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner in accordance with the MHS Student Handbook. *******

If a student is intoxicated, the police officer on the boat will notify the local police. The parent(s) will be called to come and pick-up the student as soon as the boat docks. Administration will have an alcohol testing kit. If there is suspicion, the student will be tested. Students will be separated from the group if they are under the influence until the boat docks.
